Rule Change 2301

The following series of changes are those which affect the intent of the Official Rules for the update to the 2023 season. The changes were proposed by Commissioner Jeff and approved by a unanimous, 5-0, vote from the Fantasy Board of Governors. The individual changes are listed below:

RC2301-A: Increase the maximum number of reserves allowed from 8 to 10. (This change was included in the 2022 Official Rules as a planned change for 2023).

RC2301-B: Increase the Initial Roster from 18 to 20. (This change was included in the 2022 Official Rules as a planned change for 2023).

RC2301-C: Increase the salary cap for Initial Rosters from \$28,000,000 to \$30,000,000 (to compensate for the two additional reserved players, at \$1,000,000 each).

RC2301-D: Increase the Seasonal Roster from 20 to 22, the Active Roster from 17 to 18 players, and the Taxi Squad from 3 to 4. (This change was included in the 2022 Official Rules as a planned change for 2023).

RC2301-E: In Section 10 (provisions for seasons beyond 2023), include the provision to plan for the increase of reserved players from 10 to 11 for the 2024 season. Keep the Initial Roster at 20 and the Seasonal Roster at 22 and the split between the Active Roster and Taxi Squad at 18/4.

Comments from Commissioner Jeff: These changes are consistent with the planned changes for the 2023 season which were listed in the 2022 Official Rules. They were also communicated to the Fantasy Board of Governors earlier this year with each provision supported by at least 3 governors. No other proposals communicated during that review period were supported by more than 2 governors so those are not included in this Rule Change proposal. Other proposals can be re-tendered at any point in time.
